TRANSPORTATION

Maps, timetables, fares and route planning are available in English on the Prague public transport website <u>www.dpp.cz/en/</u>.

From the Václav Havel Airport to conference venue

It is possible to get from the airport to the centre of Prague either by taxi or public transport.

- <u>taxi service</u> the journey will take about 30 minutes and should not cost more than 750 CZK or 30 EUR. It is recommended to use one of the alternative online taxi services such as Uber, Bolt or Liftago, which are very reliable and widely used in Prague.
- <u>public transport</u> bus number 119 to metro station "Nádraží Veleslavín" (15 min) and then take the green metro line A to station "Muzeum" (13 min), then transfer to the red metro line C to station "Vyšehrad" (3 min). The journey will take about 40 minutes.

From Main Railway Station to conference venue

The railway station is located in the city centre near Wenceslas Square. The entrance to the metro ("Hlavní nádraží") is located directly in the vestibule area of Prague Main Railway Station. Follow the sign with the direction Háje (see image below). "Vyšehrad" station is the third metro stop from "Hlavní nádraží" station. Travel time is approximately 5 minutes.











Public transport in Prague is very efficient, reliable and economical. Tickets can be purchased in the mobile application "PID Lítačka", in contactless terminals in every moving tram and metro stations, in ticket machines, and in newsagents and some other shops.

30 min ticket – 30 CZK (approx. 1,3 EUR)
90 min ticket – 40 CZK (approx. 1,7 EUR)
24 hours ticket – 120 CZK (approx. 5 EUR)

Airport Express (AE) buses provide direct connections to Václav Havel Prague Airport. Travel time is approximately 30 minutes.
